IDENTIFY

CASE

STUDENT / STAFF / VISITOR?

SYMPTOMS

FEVER (≥37.5°C), COUGH, BODY ACHE OR FATIGUE, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, SORE THROAT, RUNNY NOSE, DIARRHEA AND NAUSEA, HEADACHE, OR LOSS OF SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE

LOCATION

WHERE HAS THE CASE BEEN DETECTED - BUILDING AND EXACT LOCATION

NOTIFY

THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL CONTACT THE DHA HOTLINE NUMBER 800-342 IMMEDIATELY AND ANY OTHER RELEVANT CONTACTS

ACT

- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL THEN ASK THE PATIENT TO REMAIN IN THAT LOCATION /OR DIRECT THIS INDIVIDUAL TO A REMOTE LOCATION AWAY FROM THE PUBLIC IF IT IS SAFE TO DO SO.
- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL WEAR THE APPROPRIATE PPE AND MAKE HIS WAY TO MEET THE PATIENT.
- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL USE CORDONS AND PORTABLE SCREENS TO SECURE THE AREA

ISOLATE

- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL ASSIST THE PATIENT TO REACH THE ISOLATION ROOM.
- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL CONTACT ON-SITE SECURITY TO ASSIST WITH MAKING A FREE WAY TOWARDS THE ISOLATION ROOM.
- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL MAKE CONTACT WITH DHA FOR FURTHER ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE. BASED ON THE PATIENT CONDITION, H&S WILL ASSESS AND MAKE A JUDGMENT CALL IF AN AMBULANCE IS REQUIRED AT THAT STAGE.
- THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER WILL ENSURE TRACK AND TRACING REPORTS ARE AVAILABLE AND READY, SHOULD THEY BE REQUIRED.
